We have put together a collection of some of our favourite and most popular garden plants for your interest and information.

Agapanthus "Northern Star – Violet blue with purple stripe. 80cm. Free-flowering \*AGM

Allium sphaerocephalon – Maroon red, drumstick type. 80 cm. Unusual \*AGM

Alstromeria 'Indian Summer' – Creamy yellow/red orange. Flowers June-Oct. Bronze foliage 80cm. Dependable

Anchusa 'Dropmore' – Blue. Flowers May-July. 90cm. Self-seeding. Surprisingly reliable

Aster 'Monch' – Blue. Flowers July-Oct. 70cm. Good mildew resistance. Eye-catching colour & early flowering \*AGM

Buddleia 'Prince Charming' – Cherry Pink 1.2m Flowers June-Sept. Delightful

Dahlia 'Mystic Illusion' – Lemon yellow, single flowers with mahogany black foliage. 90cm. Outstanding

Dahlia 'Rancho' – Apricot/yellow waterlily like flowers. 1 m. Flowers July until first frost. Exceptional

Echinacea 'Sensation Pink' – Deep magenta pink. 50cm. Suitable for pots. Reliable

Erigeron karvinskianus – White with hint of pink, daisy like. Grows well in most soil conditions, including poor & dry. Self-seeds. Dainty. Good for pots \*AGM

Eryngium 'Big Blue' – Steely blue thistle like flowers. Good for drying. 75cm. Striking \*AGM

Geranium 'Rozanne' – Vibrant blue. Flowers May-Nov. 40 cm. Easy & reliable \*AGM

Geranium 'Patricia' – Magenta flowers with black eye. Flowers May-Oct. 75cm. \*AGM

Geum 'Totally Tangerine' – Peachy orange. 90cm. Flowers May – July. Remove spent flowers & stems for long flowering. Late spring wonder

Hydrangea arborescens 'Invincibelle Spirit Pink Annabelle'. Bright pink maturing to soft pink. Collection of small flowers creating a ball. 1.2m. Flowers on new spring growth. Good for drying.

Hydrangea paniculata 'Vanilla Fraise' -Creamy white tinged with pink, maturing to rich red. Large cone shaped flowers. 1.6m. Flowers June to first frost. Avoid roots drying out to maintain flower performance. Good for drying

Lavandula angustifolia 'Havana' – Purple spikes, aromatic foliage. 60cm. English lavender, recent introduction – possible improvement on Hidcote variety.

*Lavandula angustifolia* 'Essence Purple' – deep violet spikes English lavender. 40cm. Requires annual prune (late August, early September). Add lime to acidic soils and allow space between neighbouring plants.

*Phlox paniculata* 'David' – White, fragrant. 90cm. Feeding with nutrient will enhance performance. Striking \*AGM

Rose 'James Galway' – Mid-pink centre paler hues to edge of petals. Bush or will climb to 10ft. Repeat flower. Medium old rose fragrance. Flowers June to first frost.

Rose 'Super Trouper' – Vibrant Orange. Medium scent and repeat flower. 90cm. Eye-catching \*AGM

*Salvia* 'Amistad' – Violet, purple/blue. 1 m. Flowers continue from June to first frost. Mulch 3" compost or lift and protect from frost. Wonderful plant. \*AGM

*Salvia* 'Hot Lips' – Red & white. (Sometimes flowers appear all white or all red beginning or end of season). 80cm. Scented foliage. A top garden plant. \*AGM

*Stipa tenuissima* 'Pony Tails' – Pale green foliage with fluffy delicate plumes. June-Sept. 50cm. Self-seeds. Cut back or divide to keep fresh. Suitable for poor soil. \*AGM

*Pennisetum macrourum* 'White Lancer'. African Feather Grass. Long flower spikes, clump forming. 1.5m upright. Creates movement. Great for flower arranging.

*Verbena bonariensis* - Violet/purple tall stems with delicate flower heads. 1.2m. Easy to grow and self-seeds. Multi-plant for effect. A must have. \*AGM
